

One of the essential characteristics of the Master's in Creative Documentary is its role in promoting three films per edition, always in collaboration with independent producers. Collectively, these films have profoundly renewed the style and reach of documentary cinema.

Each of these films has been developed by filmmakers working closely with a small group of students from each edition, fostering a form of generational transmission that has been recognized as a European reference.

The authors of these films promoted by the Master's program come from diverse backgrounds: either established filmmakers experimenting with reality-based cinema or former students of the program who have had the opportunity to create a film that helps launch their careers and establish themselves in the international film industru.

All of these films have been made possible thanks to the commitment to creative documentary demonstrated by various television networks, particularly Televisión Española, Televisió de Catalonia, Arte, Canal Plus/Movistar Plus, and the streaming platform Filmin, all of which have participated in different ways in films developed within the program.

Likewise, this transformative presence in documentary cinema has been supported from the very beginning by public institutions at the Catalan, Spanish, and European levels. The ICEC, ICAA, Eurimages, and other regional funding bodies are acknowledged in the credits of each film as a testament to the creative alliance and deep confidence in the public value of documentary cinema.
